

Rules for the Protection of Children's Personal Information

Privacy Policy for Children

FUJIFILM (China) Investment Co., Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as “Fujifilm” or “we”) places great importance on the protection of personal information and privacy of children (defined as minors under the age of fourteen). In accordance with Article 31 of the Personal Information Protection Law, and building upon the “FUJIFILM (China) Investment Co., Ltd.. Privacy Policy” (hereinafter referred to as the “Privacy Policy”), we have established this “Policy on the Protection of Children’s Personal Information” (hereinafter referred to as “this Policy”) to protect your child’s personal information and privacy.

Please know and understand that this Policy is a special rule based on the Privacy Policy, and if there is any inconsistency with the terms and provisions of the Privacy Policy, this Policy shall prevail; Please refer to the Privacy Policy for anything not specified in this Policy.

Special Note for Guardians:

If you are the guardian of a child user, please be sure to read this policy carefully and fully understand it. Only after confirming that you fully understand and agree to all

the terms of this policy should you allow your child to use the products and/or services we provide. Your understanding and cooperation are essential to our ability to protect your child's personal information and privacy. To safeguard your child's legal rights and interests, we ask for your support and cooperation to ensure that your child uses our products and/or services or submits personal information to us only with your consent and under your guidance. If you do not agree with the terms of this policy, please instruct your child to immediately stop accessing and using our products and/or services.

Special Note for Children:

If you are under the age of 14, please be sure to have your guardian read this policy carefully with you and obtain your guardian's consent before using our products or services or providing us with your personal information.

1. How We Collect and Use Children’ s Personal Information

We will strictly fulfill our legal obligations and responsibilities regarding the protection of children’ s personal information, adhering to the principles of legitimacy and necessity, informed consent, specified purpose, security safeguards, and lawful use. We will collect and use children’ s personal information only after obtaining the consent of their guardians. By voluntarily providing us with your child’ s personal information when using our products and/or services, you agree to our collection and use of your child’ s personal information in accordance with our Privacy Policy and this policy.

We may also automatically collect personal information about you or your child through the use of cookies. For more details, please refer to the “8. Use of Cookies and Similar Technologies” section of our Privacy Policy. If we need to use children’ s personal information for purposes or in a manner beyond those described above, we will obtain the guardian’ s consent again.

Please note that in the vast majority of cases, we are unable to identify or determine whether the personal information we collect and process pertains to children. In such cases, we will collect and process users’ personal information in accordance with our Privacy Policy.

2. How We Share, Process on Behalf Of, Transfer, and Disclose Children’ s Personal Information

We are committed to keeping children's personal information strictly confidential, and only share children's personal information in accordance with the Privacy Policy and this policy description and your express authorization and consent:

1. Provide to the guardian. Guardians can access and manage the personal information of the children under their care.
2. For the purposes stated in the Privacy Policy and this Policy, we will share, delegate processing, transfer and publicly disclose information about children with the consent of our guardians based on the circumstances described in the "3. Sharing, Entrusted Processing, Transfer, and Public Disclosure of Personal Information" section of the Privacy Policy.

3. How We Store Children' s Personal Information

1. As a general rule, we will store personal information of children that we collect and generate within the territory of the People' s Republic of China within the territory of the People' s Republic of China.
2. We will take reasonable and feasible measures to avoid collecting and processing personal information about children that is not relevant to our purposes. We will only store children's information within the period for which the purposes stated in the Privacy Policy and this Policy are fulfilled, and we will delete children's personal information after fulfilling the relevant purposes. Please refer to the "4. Storage and Protection of Personal Information" section of our Privacy Policy for details on how we store children' s personal information.

4. How We Protect Children’ s Personal Information

We take the protection of children’ s personal information very seriously and take all reasonable and feasible measures to protect it:

1. We will collect personal information from children in connection with the products and/or services we provide in accordance with the principles of legitimacy and necessity, informed consent, specified purpose, security safeguards, and lawful use.
2. If we discover that a child’ s personal information has been or may be leaked, damaged, or lost, we will, in accordance with applicable laws and regulations, activate our emergency response plan, take remedial measures, promptly report the incident to the relevant competent authorities, and notify the affected children and their guardians of the relevant details via email, letter, telephone, or push notifications. If it is impractical to notify each individual separately, we will issue relevant warning notices through reasonable and effective means.
3. For more information, please refer to the “4. Storage and Protection of Personal Information” section of our Privacy Policy.

5. How We Manage Children’ s Personal Information

To make it easier for you and your child to access and manage your child’ s personal information while using our products and/or services, and to ensure your right to withdraw consent, you and your child may follow the instructions in Section 5,

“ User’s Personal Information Rights and Interests,” of our Privacy Policy.

In the following circumstances, you or your child may contact us to request the deletion of the relevant children' s information:

- (1) We collect, store, use, transfer, or disclose a child' s personal information in violation of laws, administrative regulations, or the agreement between the parties;
- (2) Collecting, storing, using, transferring, or disclosing children ' s personal information beyond the scope of the intended purpose or the necessary period;
- (3) You have withdrawn your consent;
- (4) You or your child discontinues use of the product or service.

6. Revisions to and Notification of This Policy

1. To better protect your child' s personal information, we will revise this policy as laws, regulations, and other social norms in China and other relevant countries and regions change.
2. We will not curtail the rights you and your child are entitled to under this policy without your and your child' s explicit consent.
3. If this policy is revised, we will notify you and your child of the updates by posting a prominent notice on our official website, issuing an announcement, or using other appropriate means before the revisions take effect.
4. We will archive previous versions of this policy for you and your child to review.
